



Project WARM

One cold winter night is one too many for the Houston area individuals and animals who do not have the resources to stay warm.

In winters past, we at Friends for Life have built and distributed small weatherproof shelters for feral/outdoor cats in the Houston area to keep them warmer during winter. The design is one created by a shelter in Michigan and it uses sheet foam rubber, a Rubbermaid tub/top and some hay. We have partnered with itscool2care to facilitate school classes that helped to assemble the materials and create the houses.

As we geared up to gather the supplies and people power to create this year's feral houses, and to collect cat food supplies to help feed the cats, we realized that the neighborhoods in which we distribute the houses to keep the cats warm often contain people who also may not have enough to keep themselves warm.

Project WARM, a partnership with itscool2care and The Midtown Spirituality Center, represents our unified response to address both human and animal needs.

Through Project WARM we will be collecting cat supplies to help keep outdoor cats warm and fed during the winter months, as well as gathering coats, blankets and other cold weather essentials for those in need of some extra warmth this season. We will be accepting donations throughout November, leading up to assembly and delivery events during December.

Get Involved

Project WARM: We Are Responsible for More.

You can help in many ways. We need:

Cash donations for pet food; feral cat house materials such as covered bins, straw, and foam rubber; blankets; coats and other cold weather essentials

- A donation of \$100 will purchase 10 blankets or four coats
- A donation of \$50 will purchase a complete feral cat home, pet food and blankets
- A donation of \$25 will purchase one feral cat home



Donations of wet and dry cat and dog food such as small bags of Purina dry cat/kitten and dog food and cans of 9lives, Fancy Feast, Friskies or other high quality canned food

New and gently used blankets, coats, scarves, hats and mittens

Donation of time to help assemble the feral cat homes, gather and sort coats and blankets, and distribute the supplies to area residents in need.
